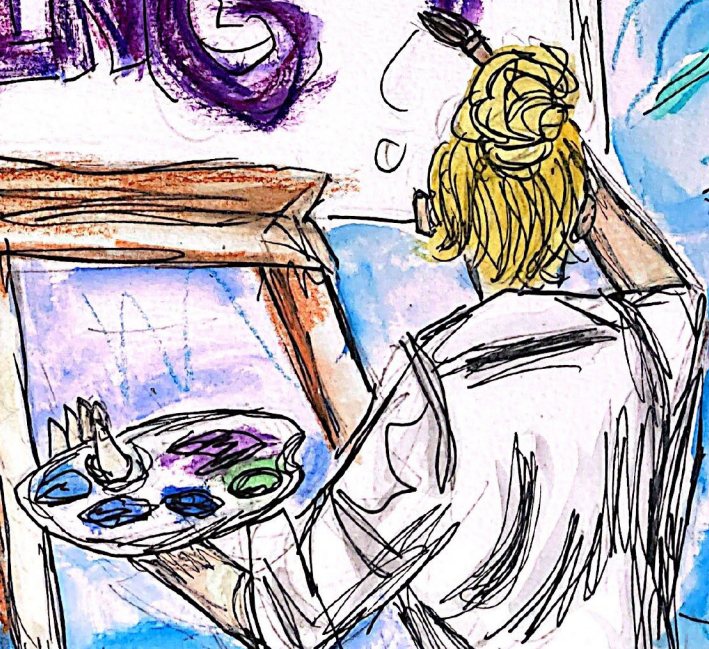

through the air?



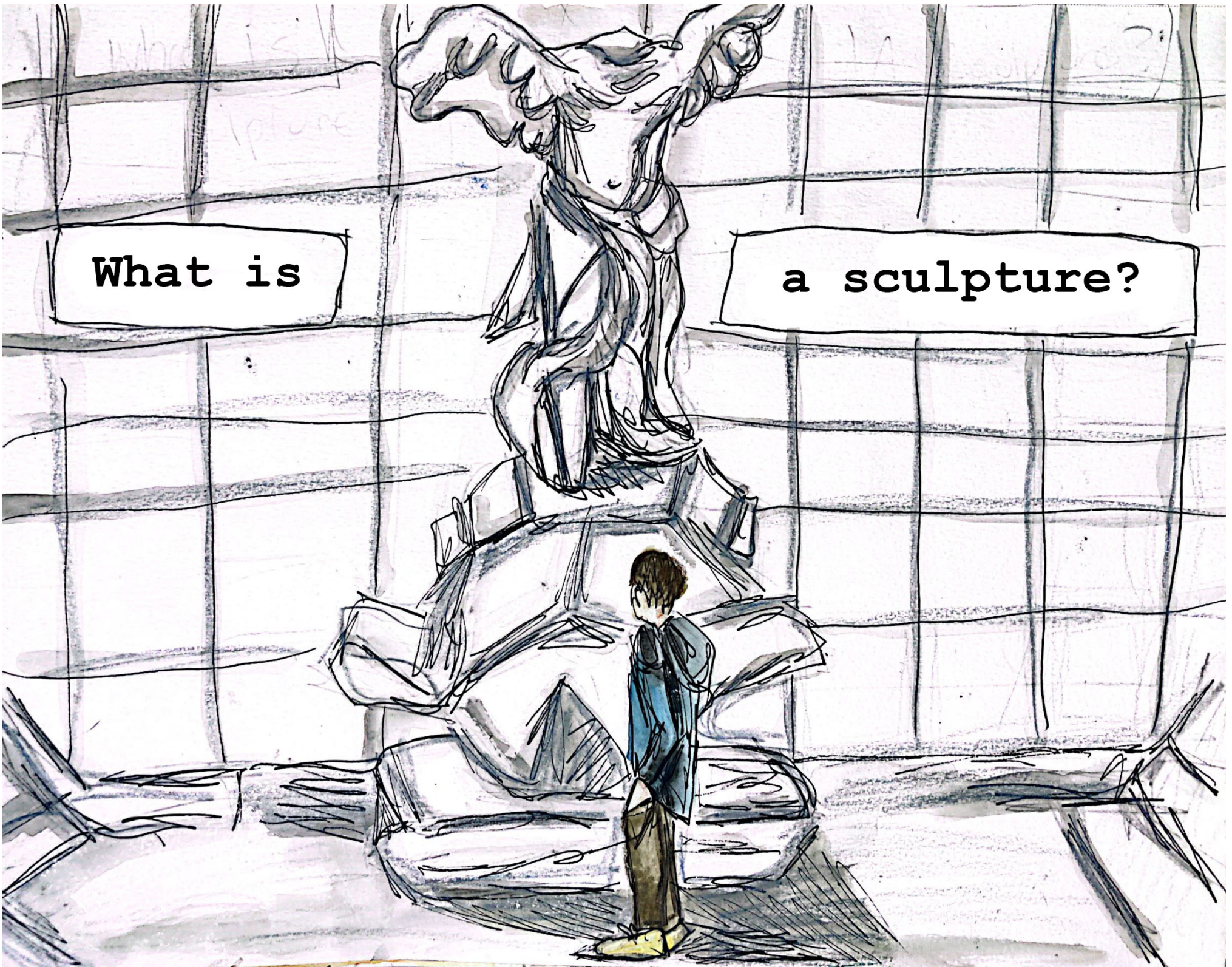

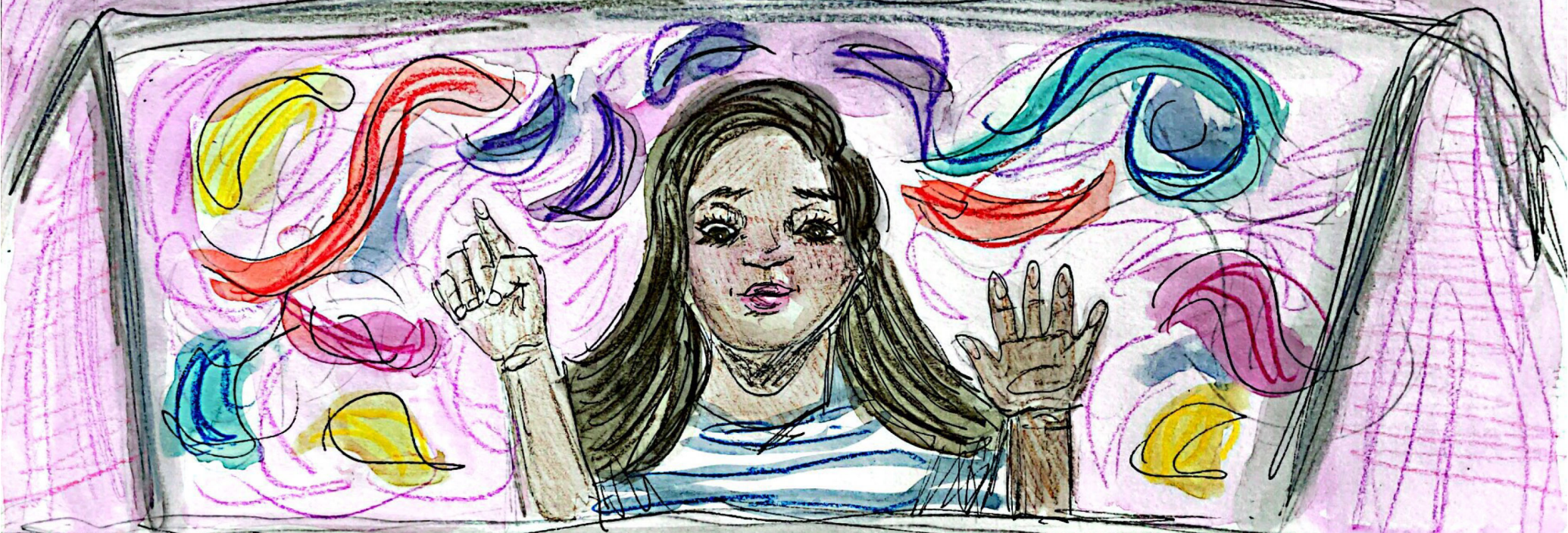

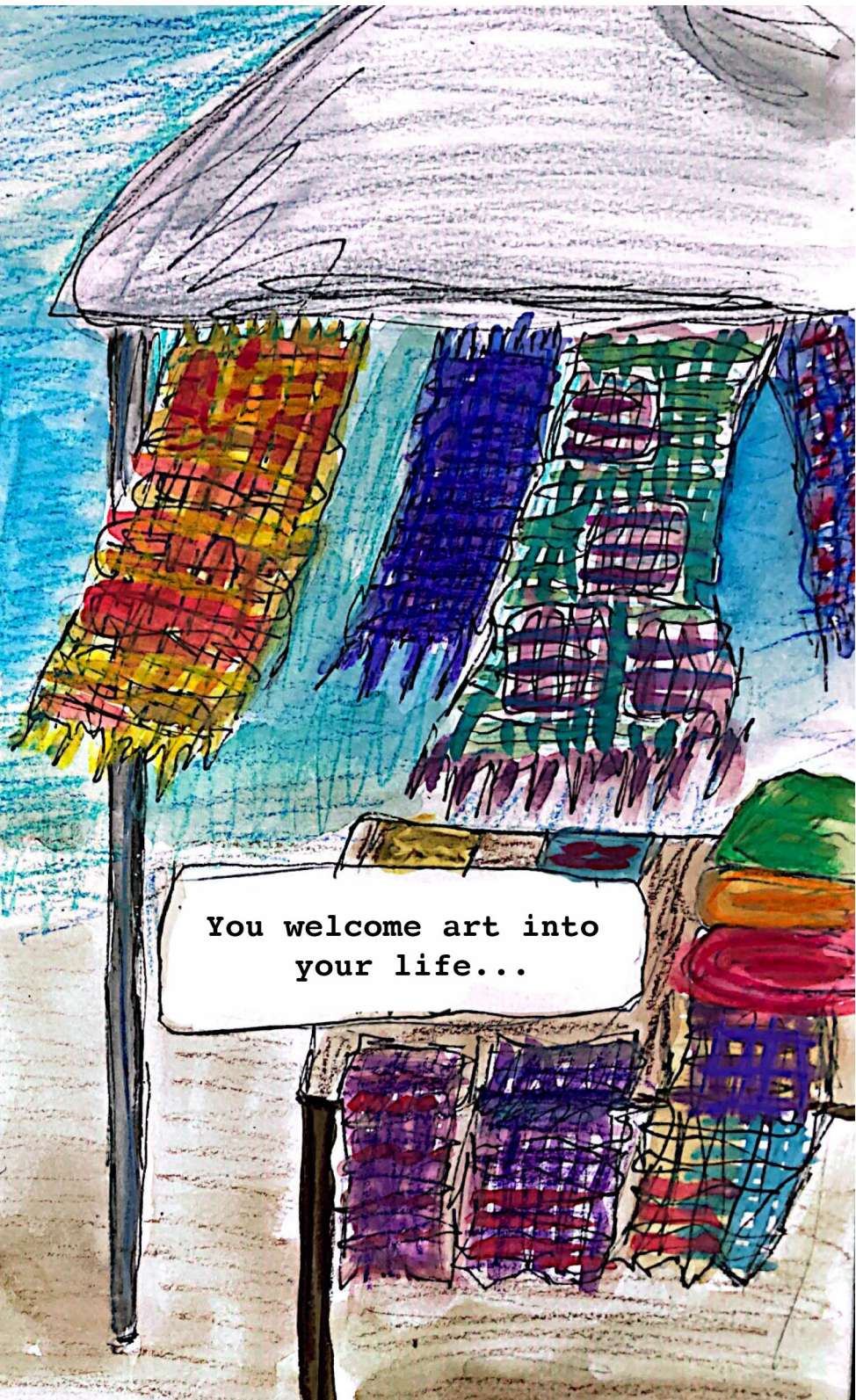
